

#### Introduce of Language School

The language school of Sunmoon university was established on the 20th of March 1989, with the purpose of spreading and promoting the Korean language and culture worldwide.

Since its foundation until February 2021, over 27,495 students from 154 countries have attended the Korean language course at Sunmoon Korean Language Institute. #### Test of Proficiency in Korean(TOPIK)

Sunmoon University is one of the official institutions managing the TOPIK exam, which is held in the university 6 times per year. #### Entrance Process and Flight Information

- Student flight information will be provided 1 week before the start of each semester.
- Since it takes approximately 3 hours to go to Sunmoon university from Incheon airport, if possible, arrange your flight arriving time before 4pm.
- You will be quarantined according to the COVID19 situation.
- After purchasing the flight ticket, make sure to forward your name (in English), gender, date of departure, time of departure, time of arrival and the flight number to the language institute.

#### Visa Information

- Students wishing to participate in the regular course must apply for a general training (D-4-1) visa. Depending on the country, the required documents may differ, so please refer to your local Korean embassy or consulate in advance.
- •The D-4-1 visa is valid for 6 months and can be extended up to 2 years at the immigration office in Korea. After submitting the required documents (admission letter, reference letter, proof of tuition payment etc.) to the Korean embassy or consulate, the visa will be issued after a screening procedure. Since the process of obtaining D-4-1 visa usually takes 1 month, it's advisable to start the procedure at least 2 months before of the start of the semester.


